The following request for clarification was received by this office.

CLARIFICATION NO. 2

Request for Clarification:

Re. surveys, can you clarify the below:

*1) Is there the need to include the logo of Norway grants on the survey sheet?
(if it is to be done by hand)'*

Reply from the SGSO:

- a. Yes. Norway grant logos need to be included both in the survey sheet and in the methodology report that is to be presented with the survey results.
- b. For those who will be carrying out the survey by phone, it is important that they indicate clearly that the survey that they are carrying out is in connection with a project co-financed by the Norway Funds.
- c. For the survey that is to be carried out **at the end of the project by phone**, which survey states:
 - 'How satisfied are you with the Local Council's performance in your locality..... after the implementation of the project that bears the title of.....?'
 - **one needs to include:** '.....after the implementation of the project that bears the title of....., which project was co-funded by the Norway Funds allocated to the Maltese Local

Government Division'. (Annexe 3 of the application form attached has been updated accordingly).

2) *Can the survey sheet be provided in both English and Maltese? (if so, the translation can be done by local council).*
