

Communication with Residents:

- 1) Resident in Triq Santu Wistin:
 - a. Timed parking in Santu Wistin should be amended to better suit the residents. [This I believe is already included in the report to be sent to TM]
 - b. A one way system (except for residents) should be introduced in Triq Santu Wistin. Apparently something similar has already been adopted for the road of the chapel nearby.
- 2) Arnold Cassola:
 - a. Loading/Unloading times should be reduced in order to increase parking spaces for residents.
 - b. Yellow lines in Triq is-Swieqi should be removed:
 - i. Infront of DVD Shop
 - ii. Other side of the road – yellow lines should only be painted in front of the block's communal garage.
 - c. Yellow lines in front of garages that have been converted into shops should be removed.
- 3) Mark Azzopardi and other residents from Swieqi Residential Complex:
 - a. A Rubbish Skip to service Swieqi Residential Complex in Triq il-Qatta should be installed. Residents want the skip so that rubbish is not left running around on the pavement.
- 4) Residents in Triq il-Keffa (as per petition).
 - a. Disturbances by foreign Students should be stopped after 11pm. The shouting, chaos and general noise pollution is of a great disturbance to the residents in the area. The police, when called, eventually turn up but noise resumes once they leave. Video evidence was produced.
- 5) Residents from Acacia Avenue Complex:
 - a. The road opposite Acacia Avenue Complex is still not tarmaced. It is the only part of Triq ir-Ratal which remains undone.
- 6) Deaf/Mute Association
 - a. They wish to organise some events with the Local Council in order to promote the proper integration of deaf/mutes in society. [My proposal is for them to take part in Swieqi Day and that the Local Council organise something during their Deaf/Mute week].

Issues to be raised:

- 1) The Mayor received a report of all Traffic Warden activity in the Swieqi area. It is clear that there is an imbalance in the way public order is being enforced. We should meet with the authority in charge of Wardens and thrash out the issue with them.
- 2) Parking Bays in bottom of Triq il-Qasam have not been repainted.
