2 – SeeMore Project

This project is to introduce energy efficient transport solutions for visitors in eight coastal tourist regions of Europe. Participating regions are; Balearic Islands, Forli-Cesena, Dobrich, Pomerania, Madeira, Limassol and Malta. The project is co-financed by the intelligent Energy Europe Programme. Coastal regions are popular destinations for holidays. To maintain their attractiveness, these regions have to effectively manage to way tourists go around during their stay. A high use of private cars and rentals can lead to an unsustainable increase in pollution, fuel consumption and traffic jams. Without an efficient plan for visitors' mobility, the attractiveness and economic future of these regions is in jeopardy. It is in this context that SEEMORE arises... a project initiated by 8 tourist regions within the EU. We are trying to introduce sustainable options for tourists to go around the islands. Most of the tourists, especially in Malta rent a car and we want to change this by trying to offer safe and comfortable alternatives. Our aim is to reduce car use by 15% and increase by 10% the number of non motorized tours. To achieve this, online information is imperative to enable and allow tourists to plan their stay from home. This info campaign will be reinforced through message at the airports, train stations, bus stops, tourists info points and hotels. The second step of initiatives is to increase of services and infrastructure to provide comfortable, convenient and alternative transport methods such as improved public transport, walking routes and where possible bicycle lanes. Also we are trying to introduce measures to combine public transport with leisure activities such as connecting hotels shuttle services to tourists attractions, small mobile trains and other similar initiatives. Meetings and seminars are organized regularly to share experiences and good practices with other tourists regions and learn from each other. Malta is represented by the Association of Local Government.
