Herewith summary accompanied by notes where appropriate in respect of those points raised by myself during the above meeting held on the 29th May and to be attached as Appendix 'B' to the corresponding minutes:

01. Annual Locality Meeting Minutes – (Exec. Sec. confirmed done but yet to be distributed to all.)
02. Triq is-Swieqi – Entrance Tunnel sponsored upgrading - (Mayor once again confirmed that official permit approval still awaited)
03. Council Meetings Streaming online - (Exec. Sec. confirmed that completion of further technical requirements had delayed installation)
04. Directional Maps – (Exec. Sec. & Deputy Mayor to obtain more information from other localities where such boards had been installed)
05. F.X. Ebejer Public Garden in Triq is-Swieqi – (My suggestion of surrounding the outdoor equipment area with low wooden fencing was considered unnecessary)
06. Gieh is-Swieqi Annual Award – (Time constraints due to lack of quorum precluded further discussion, which issue to be finalized on the 26th June)
07. Street Sweeping/Weed Cutting Contract – (Exec. Sec. confirmed that although additional conditions for incorporation to the original contract had been drafted, these required both his signature and those of the Mayor and Contractor for purposes of extending the existing agreement for a further twelve months commencing the 5th May, 2014)
08. Triq is-Sidra – (Following complaints by various residents about the filthy state of the awnings covering the reservoir of St. Andrew's Farm, the Exec. Sec. had notified the owners to remedy the problem. However the situation remained as was and the stagnant water on parts of the inappropriate and torn covers were creating infestation of mosquitoes to the annoyance and inconvenience to nearby residents.)
09. Triq il-Qasam Zebra Crossing Lights outside the Corner Store – Notwithstanding reports lodged with the contractor over the past two months, these were still not functioning. (Exec. Sec. confirmed that although he had attempted to repair both lights, he had not yet succeeded in tracing the fault. This would be done over the coming days?)
10. Lifelong Learning Courses – (Exec. Sec. confirmed that reimbursement from the authorities concerned was still awaited)
11. Mlca Med - the contractor concerned had not yet been notified about the necessity to include the following dates when invoicing, precisely: Works Orders, Completion of Repairs and Actual Invoice date.
