Storm Water

On 18/07 the executive secretary and my self met officials from the 'storm water' department so as to assess the situation in Triq il-Qasam near Forex with regards to the foul smells that come out of the existing culverts and whether a solution could be found to the excess of water that flows from St Andrews road into Triq il-Qasam.

These officials concluded that the existing culverts had to remain as they are and that they would be trying to solve the 'flood' problem by creating culverts in St Andrews road.

Various residents turned up during this meeting so as to express themselves against the current situation and demanded that things be remedied.

Revision of the Local Plan

On 24/07 the council met officials from Mepa and the reforms to the local plan was discussed.

Council drew the attention of the officials that too much development was taking place in the locality and this was creating a huge strain on the locality's infrastructure and well being.

The height of the buildings as well the size of the rooms was discussed. Council emphasised that it was against the construction of small apartments.

Council drew the attention of the officials of a number of shops that opened when in actual fact it is not very clear whether the original plans had included the opening of shops. Thus the situation of the shops in Triq is-Swieqi was discussed.
