Subject: VARIOUS MATTERS

Dear Hugh,

- a. **Triq is-Swieqi** - An unloading/loading sign is lying on the pavement next to Georgette Galea's residence at 182 'Capri Rocks'. It was too heavy for me to pick up and lock in my garage and Johnny best collect soonest to avoid disappearance.
- b. **Triq Villa Rosa** - Following Transport Malta's request for a picture of the damaged *kurdun* and mess c/w Triq Sant'Andrija reported recently, it is hoped that someone has done the necessary for submission to the authorities to undertake repairs as urgently as possible.
- c. **Legal Notices/Regulations** - For purposes of easier reference, suggest that a special file be kept with those notices of importance for purposes of facilitating access when required.
- d. **Council Meeting Minutes No.20** - As already explained to Clarissa, item IV/1 on page 6 needs to be further amended inasmuch as this did not reflect what I had singled out. Indeed approval of the document was subject to clarification of those points raised by me as outlined in my e-mail attached as an appendix A and as referred to on page 2/2 under my name.
- e. **Madliena Admin. Committe Minutes** for period Jan/June '13 still awaited. Circulation to all councillors as it was in their interest to be kept informed of developments.
- f. **Street Sweeping Contractor** - Street by street works schedule also to be circulated to all for monitoring purposes.
- g. **Triq L-Ghamad** - Any development over necessity to prune large tree growing in garden of residence number 26 and which is concealing the on wall street light?
- h. **Seconded workers** - As suggested, has a letter been sent to the Ministry concerned and in particular to those potential personnel filtered through the ETC. Likewise, has the council received official confirmation of the discontinuance of the IPSL scheme? Should this be so, I had suggested the submission of an application to the Director of Local Government for the council to engage a suitable person as Johnny cannot cope with his present workload.
- i. **Police Vice Squad** - Has a date been fixed for a meeting with officials responsible following their of the 16th July?
- j. **Culverts** - Yet again we are late in issuing calls for the annual cleaning up of culverts which common sense dictates that this be done before the rainy season.
- k. **Contracts/Tenders** - An updated list to include the architect who was omitted from the last information provided. This should enable the council to avoid delays in the renewal and/or tender awards and which go contrary to existing regulations. The problem over the Lease of a Vehicle Tender was unfortunate but the necessary document should be issued in time for the meeting on the 31st July.
- l. **Triq is-Swieqi** - Any developments concerning the empty plot (more of a mizbla) adjacent to the Golosa outlet. Suggest that pictures are taken of this plot to dispel any idea that urgent action need not be taken.
- m. **Sqaq Lourdes** - Any developments over removal of the Reserved Parking signage outside residence number 21?
